MACAW

This is a photograph of a Green Winged Macaw in the Amazon jungle. Most macaws are extremely large and colourful members of the parrot family. Some of them are endangered because hunters are illegally capturing these for the pet trade.

Traffickers are also earning lots of money on the wildlife black market, a

massive global crime which is smaller than only gun running and drugs smuggling.

Other macaws are killed for their sensationally coloured feathers, often used for ornamental clothing. One example is the Hyacinth Macaw, a rare bird that could become extinct in the near future if this trade continues to destroy wild populations.

Sadly, we are losing many members of the parrot family throughout South America and Africa far too quickly. Raising awareness about macaw survival is important for the Western World. If we can educate the public and limit illegal trading, it will be a great success.

The consequences of this project will be that the supply will be seriously undermined. With no wealthy Western customers buying these animals, hunters will not be able to earn anything. Their illegal activities will stop and the wild populations will recover.




FES has been to the Amazon, monitoring the Green Winged Macaw and other parrot species in their original habitats. We also met Brazilian parrot conservationists at work. Furthermore we have been to the United Nations Environmental

Programme (UNEP) headquarters at Geneva and have had discussions with CITES (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species).

FES aims to limit illegal trading with law enforcement through our membership of PAW (The Partnership for Action Against Wildlife Crime). In the Wildlife Zone we are raising awareness of illegal trading, hunting and trafficking.


