SEAHORSE



There are only two species of seahorse found in British waters; both of which are protected.

Seahorses are members of a magical family of animals that include pipefish and sea dragons. Throughout the world, many of the 35 species of seahorse are overfished for both the tourist and

the traditional Chinese medicine trades. In Hong Kong, for example, seahorses are worth up to \$550 per pound, which produces huge profits and leads to overfishing.

The consequences are that seahorses are left with fewer viable populations in sporadic colonies.

Because there is little or no protection to 'core populations' (ie the animals that have escaped capture), many colonies throughout the world are continually threatened.

The majority of species are in serious trouble and desperately need urgent help. We need to protect these colonies from overfishing by creating marine nature reserves that will allow only licensed fisherman the right to catch a limited stock. It has already proved to be a successful strategy.

Fishermen will then legitimately 'harvest' **Coral** nature's excess, gain a permanent and sustainable income and preserve the species' core populations.

The Wildlife Zone & FES are both now members of the United Nation's Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) and add weight to protecting marine animals, especially seahorses. FES also uses the seahorse as the Coastal and Marine Project (CAMP) logo. We have adopted Rottingdean beach in Sussex (a Site of Special Scientific Interest) as part of the nationwide beach-cleaning project where British seahorses live. FES aims to work through the IOC and to monitor British seahorses at Rottingdean and elsewhere along the British coastline.
